Cummins portable pump base limited warranty

This base limited warranty applies to all Cummins Inc. branded portable pumps identified herein ("Product"). The Product includes all components associated with the Product Serial Number (PSN) of the portable pump to include, but not limited to: engine, control, pump, trailer, and enclosure (if applicable). This base limited warranty covers any failures of the Product, under normal use and service, which result from a defect in material or factory workmanship.

Base limited warranty period

The base limited warranty start date is the date of initial startup, first rental, demonstration, 50 hours of operation, or 18 months after factory ship date, whichever is sooner. The warranty period is as follows:

Cummins responsibilities

In the event of a failure of the Product during the base limited warranty period due to defects in material or workmanship, Cummins will be responsible for only the following:

- All parts and labor required to repair the Product.
- Reasonable travel expenses to and from the Product site location.
- · Maintenance items that are contaminated or damaged by a warrantable failure.

Owner responsibilities

The owner will be responsible for the following:

- Notifying the Cummins distributor or dealer within 30 days of the discovery of failure and prior to the expiration of this warranty.
- Installing, operating, commissioning and maintaining the Product including its certified engine configuration in accordance with Cummins' published policies and guidelines.
- Providing evidence for the in-service date.
- · Providing evidence (the maintenance log) of maintenance activity.
- Providing sufficient access to and reasonable ability to remove the Product from the installation in the
 event of a warrantable failure.
- Incremental costs and expenses associated with Product removal and re-installation resulting from difficult or non-standard installations.

- Costs associated with rental of a product used to replace the Product being repaired.
- · Costs associated with labor overtime and premium shipping requested by the owner.
- Costs associated with materials (e.g., lubricating oil, coolant, filter elements, or other maintenance items)
 replaced after the warranty service unless such materials are directly related to the failure of the engine
 and cannot be reused.
- All downtime expenses, fines, applicable taxes, damages, and other losses resulting from a warrantable failure.
- Costs associated with the repair or replacement of parts that are not included in this warranty.
- Adequate proof (email, receipts, documentation, etc.) that the Product does not conform to Cummins' published standards.

Base limited warranty limitations

This base limited warranty does **not cover** Product failures resulting from:

- Inappropriate use relative to designated power rating or application guidelines.
- Inappropriate use of an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) application relative to EPA's standards.
- Normal wear and tear or corrosion.
- Negligence, accidents or misuse.
- Improper and/or unauthorized installation.
- Lack of maintenance or unauthorized repair.
- Noncompliance with any Cummins manual, published guideline, or policy.
- Use of improper or contaminated fuels, coolants or lubricants.
- Improper storage before or after use.
- Owner's delay in making Product available after notification of potential Product problem.
- Replacement parts and accessories not authorized by Cummins.
- Owner or operator abuse or neglect such as: operation without adequate coolant or lubricants; over-fueling; over-speeding; lack of maintenance to lubricating, cooling or air intake systems; delayed/late servicing and maintenance; improper storage, starting, warm-up, run-in or shutdown practices; or progressive damage resulting from a defective shutdown or warning device.
- · Damage to parts, fixtures, housings, attachments and accessory items that are not part of the Product.
- Unusual or special operating environments.

This base limited warranty does **not cover**:

- Costs of maintenance, adjustments, installation, commissioning or start-up.
- Starting batteries
- Components added to the Product after shipment from Cummins.
- Costs associated with gaining access to the Product.
- Damage to customer property.
- Repair of cosmetic damage to an enclosure after shipment from Cummins.

Cummins right to failed components

Failed components claimed under this base limited warranty remain the property of Cummins. Cummins has the right to reclaim any failed component that has been replaced under this base limited warranty.

Limitation on warranties

THE WARRANTIES SET FORTH HEREIN ARE THE SOLE WARRANTIES MADE BY CUMMINS IN REGARD TO THE PRODUCT. CUMMINS MAKES NO OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, OR OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

Limitation on liabilities

IN NO EVENT SHALL CUMMINS BE LIABLE FOR INCIDENTAL OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.

This base limited warranty shall be enforced to the maximum extent permitted by applicable law. This base limited warranty gives the owner specific rights that may vary from state to state or from jurisdiction to jurisdiction.

This warranty cannot affect any statutory rights that the consumer customer may have. Nothing in this warranty excludes or restricts any contractual rights the owner may have against third parties.
